What are your values?

- Gratitude – Appreciating and being thankful for every minute b/c it can change in a second and you don't get a re-do
 - Openness to change / non-judgment
 - Passion – truly caring with any whole heart for what I believe in
 - Integrity – doing the right thing b/c it's the right thing to do
 - Every child/adult is special and deserves to be valued no matter what (and because of what) they bring to the table

 - Core values: Honesty, passion, love, integrity
 - Always being the advocate for students!
 - With students, parents, teachers all staff
 - If you don't love it, don't do it

- What do I stand for?
 - Assuming the best about people (not gossiping / complaining)
 - Equitable access for all students
 - Being present (in the moment)
 - Believing that ‘SMART’ is not something you are or are not, but something you become (variable mindset not fixed)
 - Continually learning and growing and refining
- Equality in education, environment of acceptance,
 - Every student can learn, education of the ‘whole child’ – expand their strengths, High Expectations for every child
- Passion and compassion (for one another as staff members and for students and their families)
- Professionalism – support for others and creating and maintaining a positive working and learning environment
- Equity – making all students and families feel like they have a role in ‘our’ community and we are all learners working toward a common goal – students achievement
- I stand for:
 - Supporting our students in their learning experience here with love, consistency, preparedness, patience, and through example.
 - Teamwork – supporting other staff members in any way possible and really working together to problem solve, tie our teaching together, and to help each other stay positive
 - Making learning interactive and interesting for my students so they are thinking and engaged and feel they can be creative
 - Making all students feel welcome and valued at all times (equity and diversity)
- What do you stand for?
 - I stand for honesty and appreciation for diverse learners. Honesty leads you to ask for help and seek support to become a better teacher. Student appreciation helps support students and give them ownership in their education
 - Core Values – My core values are honesty and trust. These make up the components for an efficient classroom and effective partnerships with teachers, students, and parents.

- Core Values

- My core values are what is best for all students. Strive to always do and be better. I also think happiness is a choice and I choose to be happy – and try to infect kids with that idea. I stand for individualism, being kind to others (no matter how difficult) and empathy for all things. Also all students deserve love and safety in school.

 - Keeping up with new 'ways'
 - Creating a nurturing environment where students feel they are cared about.
- Education leads to opportunity and all children should be given the best education we can give them so they may have as many opportunities at success as possible.
 - Compassion, honesty, trust, authenticity, joy, passion, opportunity
- Core values
 - All children can learn and need to be given the appropriate resources to do so
 - Relationships are essential – across the board (integrity, honesty, trust)
 - TO value learning you must continue being a learner
- Help students to grow academically and as a person
 - To show integrity in every aspect of my life
 - Strive to be a leader within my community
 - Most importantly, always be there for my wife and new born son as he transitions through life
- Trust and respect from my colleagues, parents and students

- Family always comes first and is a priority
- Kids need to like/love school first in order to learn
- Having the trust of my colleagues, parents and students
- Having a team I can trust no matter what and they can trust me
- What do I stand for?
 - Individuals, relationships, family, growth of individuals, access to education for all
 - Core values? Creative thinking, respect, family, hard work, being in the moment, being helpful, supporting team and district and building trust
- Love is all that matters / First and foremost, the rest are details
 - Every child needs to feel like the most important person in someone's life....someone who listens, cares, loves, and is so happy to see them every time we meet. Someone who is interested, kind, gentle, thoughtful who helps them see what they can be....their strengths and how to work on needs
 - I want to be a light in every child's life! I want every child to feel their brilliance, beauty, and value
- What are your core values?
 - Respect of individuals – Families and children, colleagues, self.
 - Comprehension of obstacles that prevents achievement / removal of these when possible- adaptation when removal can not happen
 - Focus and caring about each individual. Professional respect
 - Time to perform at my best
 - Safety where it can be planned
- Core values: trustworthy, family, acceptance, respectful
 - Stand for strength and balance
 - Hardworking in all areas of life and willingness to compromise and change as needed
- Lifelong learning, Integrity, respect, enthusiasm – pursuit of excellence
 - Always do your best (achieve)
 - Honor different points of view
 - Compassion
- Excellence, respect, shared responsibility, four agreements, honor, peace building for the world, teach respect for earth, differences make it richer
 - Co-teaching supports equity, authenticity, problem solving, positive, encouragement, always a solution (win-win), all children can learn and learning can be fun
 - Safety first
 - My job is to find each student's gifts and talents and let them and their parents know about them. Guide them in how to expand them
- Honesty, Respect, Trust, High Expectations, Creative thinking, problem solving, foster a love of learning, love for ourselves and others
 - Every student can and wants to succeed
- Honesty, follow through, work hard, creative thinking and logical thinking
 - Think outside of the box, but with knowledge and past experiences guiding the decisions
 - Support others – emotionally and professionally
 - Put yourself in parent or child's place – empathy – value others
- Stand for: Always doing what is best for the kids. Supporting students and follow peers in a positive, professional, and honest manner.

 - Perseverance and dedication

 - Preparedness for work force / citizens of society
