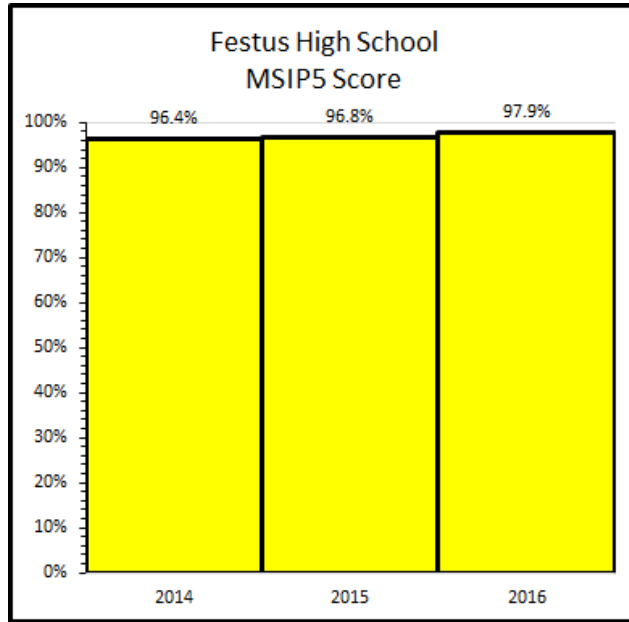


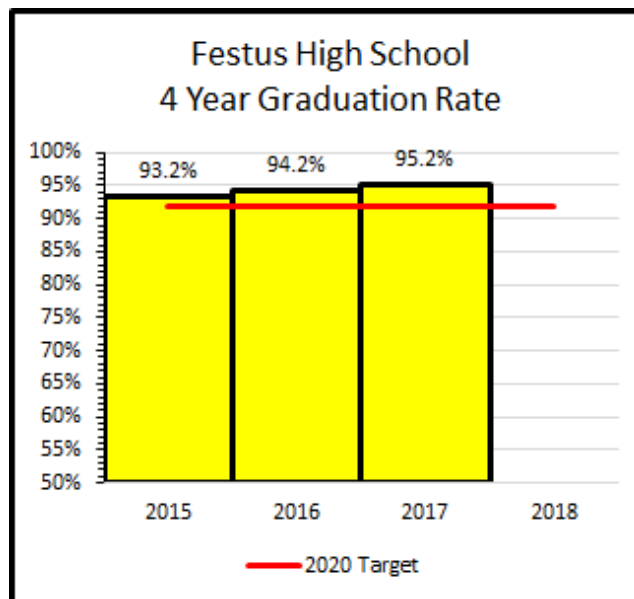
# Festus High School

## *Additional Documentation*

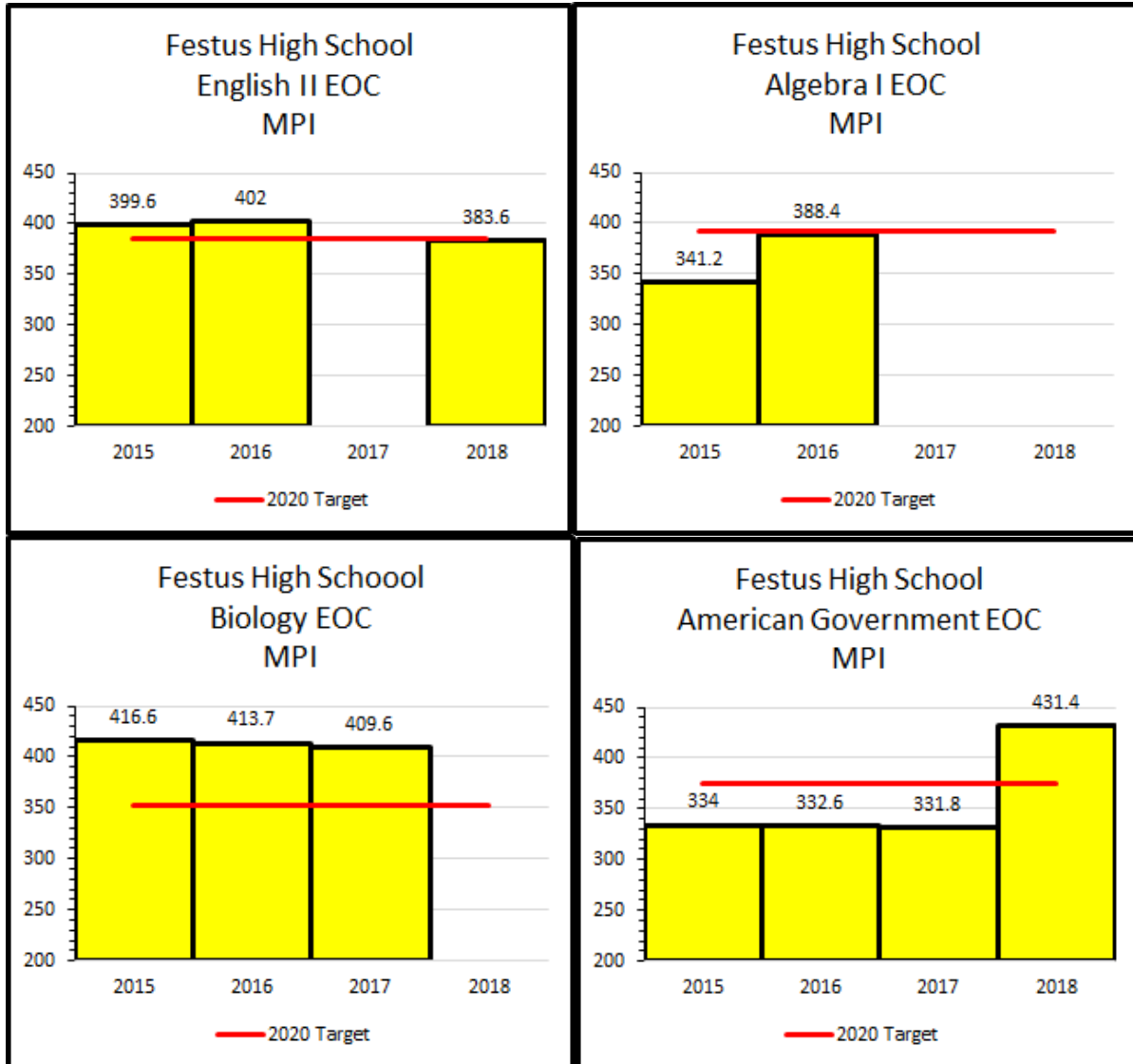
Festus High School has consistently shown growth and improvement on the Missouri School Improvement Plan (MSIP5).



Our 4 Year Graduation Rate continues to climb and remain of the state's "2020 Target" which is the goal for the year 2020.



The graphs below show our growth and achievement on the state End of Course (EOC) exams. The MAP Performance Index (MPI) is a different way the state measures a school's success on the EOC exams. The red line is the "2020 Target" for schools which is where the state wanted all scores to be above by the year 2020. As seen in the graphs, Festus High School has been above that mark in certain areas for years and has met the goal more recently.



Missouri' Department of Elementary and Secondary Education also grades high schools on how well they prepare their graduates for college and careers. DESE measures through a variety of means such as Advanced Placement, Postsecondary Placement, and CCR Assessments. These measures are complicated to explain but the following graphs are included to show how Festus High School scores compared to the state's "2020 Target."
