1st Grade Informational Writing & Science Unit

Essential Standard(s)

ELAGSE1W2: Write informative/explanatory texts in which they **name a topic**, **supply some facts** about the topic, and **provide some sense of closure**.

- This standard connects to science and social studies.
- This standard interconnects with SL.6 (speaking complete sentences) which allows the student to express his/her thinking in all subject areas.
- This standard interconnects with L.1 (writing simple sentences).

Data Celebrations with Teachers

- Following the winter and spring benchmark and the Milestones test we analyze the following to determine what we need to celebrate and areas needing improvement
 - Fall to winter, winter to spring, fall to spring for the current year
 - Current data compared to the last three years in the same grade level (different groups of students)
 - Current data compared to the last three years in the previous grade level (same group of students)
- Data to analyze
 - Percentile rank at each level
 - Lexile scores



From Renaissance to Tiger Pride

- Students are recognized based on academic growth not letter or number grades
- Areas of Celebration: more growth in math or reading, Lexile Leaper, Math Master, top five A.R. points, top three math, and top three reading
- Behavior is rewarded through PBIS celebrations



Student Data Notebooks

- Teachers decided as teams what data to track this first year. Examples include benchmark data, CFA data/proficiency towards essentials, guided reading levels, and progress in interventions.
- Students conference with the teacher to get feedback and record in their notebook.
- Students shared their data notebooks with parents following the Tiger Pride ceremony and in student-led parent conferences.
